# **BUILDING/DEMOLITION PERMITS**

Are you planning on building, renovating or demolishing? A permit issued by the Building Inspector/Development Officer is required prior to commencing any project. Contact the office or email <u>bldg@rmwhitemouth.com</u> Preparation is the key to having your project take shape as smoothly as possible. Check the website for a check list of the process and required documents, which may be a necessity.

**CONTRACTORS** - ensure all permits are in place before any work begins! Permit Fees **DOUBLE** if a project is started prior to permit approval.
