In 1985 a group of local residents, recognizing the need for local access to books, founded the Whitemouth Library.

Much has changed since then. Even though computers, internet browsing, social networking sites and smart phones are now a part of today's life, literacy and reading skills continue to be a necessity.

The library also has moved with the times, adjusting to the demand for primarily recreational reading, with the mystery section making up the largest section. To stay current we're now purchasing best sellers on a regular basis and they are highly appreciated by our readers.

Specialty books that deal with lifestyle topics such as health, nutrition and exercise are also available. Although most informational and research materials can be found on the Web, the library still has a number of interesting books on local history, stories about early Whitemouth and its people, the Whiteshell and a collection of school yearbooks.

Your library has a regular stock of over 5000 books as well as a selection of 400 books, changing every 6 months, made available through the Traveling Library.

Celebrating Literacy

In addition to providing the regular library services, the Whitemouth Library is devoting a lot of its efforts promoting literacy, specifically directed at children. The

ability to read is an essential tool for dealing with the complexities of today's information age.

Reading can be entertaining, informative and thought provoking.

To instill a love of reading, the library has a large children's book section, offers an interactive CD read-along program where story telling is combined with crafts as well as outreach programs that include reading to children at elementary schools.
