FIRE DEPARTMENT

Burning Permits are required from April 1st to November 15th, available at the Rennie District office – 204-369-3153

FREE WATER TESTING FOR LEAD IN DRINKING WATER

The Province of Manitoba and the RM recommend residents who own homes older than 1990 and are hooked up to municipal water get tested for lead. Looking for residents in the Elma area. Limited space available, first come, first serve basis.

Water from the Water Treatment Plant meets the lead limit guidelines, however, lead can enter drinking water from lead-based plumbing materials. Testing the water in your home will help the RM assess whether lead is present and the best course of action to take if it exceeds guidelines.
