BY-LAW NO. 625/14

BEING A BY-LAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF WHITEMOUTH TO CLOSE A MUNICIPAL ROAD

WHEREAS The Municipal Act provides in part as follows:

290(1) Subject to subsection (2), a municipality may close a municipal road by

(a) passing a by-law closing the road;

- (b) obtaining written approval of the by-law from the minister; and
- (c) registering the approved by-law and a plan at the appropriate land titles office.
- 291(2) "A municipality may authorize the sale of land on which was situated a municipal road that has been or is to be closed under section 290 only with the written approval of the minister."

AND WHEREAS the following described municipal road is no longer required for public purposes and it is necessary and desirable and in the public interest that the road be closed:

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Rural Municipality of Whitemouth enacts as follows:

- 1. THAT the portion of municipal road described as follows be closed:
 - All that portion of Wardrop Way, Plan 50832 in the S.W. ¼ of Section 36-11-11 EPM contained within the limits of Parcel A on a Plan prepared by Douglas Theodore Stevens of the City of Winnipeg, Manitoba, Land Surveyor and sworn to by him on the 9th day of January, 2013 (Deposit No. 1211/2012).
- 2. THAT the Reeve and Chief Administrative Officer are authorized to execute all documents necessary to carry out the provisions of this By-law.

DONE AND PASSED as a by-law of The Rural Municipality of Whitemouth in the Province of Manitoba this 5th day of February, 2015.


