## THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF WHITEMOUTH

## BY-LAW NO. 582/12

BEING A BY-LAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF WHITEMOUTH TO AMEND BY-LAW 478/07 REGULATING THE PROCEEDINGS AND CONDUCT OF THE COUNCIL AND THE COMMITTEES THEREOF

WHEREAS Section 147 (1) of Part 5, Division 1 of The Municipal Act provides in part as follows:

147(1) The power to pass a by-law under this or any other Act includes the power to amend or repeal the by-law.

AND WHEREAS Section 147 (2) of Part 5, Division 1 of The Municipal Act provides in part as follows:

147(2) The amendment or repeal of a by-law is subject to the same requirements that apply to passing the by-law, unless this or any other Act expressly provides otherwise.

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient and in the best interests of the residents of The Rural Municipality of Whitemouth that The Rural Municipality of Whitemouth amend By-Law 478/07

NOW THEREFORE BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ENACTED that the Council of The Rural Municipality of Whitemouth, duly assembled, enact as follows:

- 1. **THAT** item 2.0 (j) of By-Law 478/07 be amended to include: Louis Riel Day
- 2. THAT item 8.4 of By-Law 478/07 be amended to state: Notice of any change of day or time of a regular meeting of council must be posted in the municipal office and on the municipal website at least seven (7) days before the regularly scheduled date of the meeting.
- 3. THAT item 10.1 of By-Law 478/07 be amended to state: To allow members of council to prepare for delegations, all presenters may register with the Chief Administrative Officer at least 126 hours before the council meeting and advise the Chief Administrative Officers of the topic and scope of the presentation. All delegations shall be recognized during Council meetings.
- 4. **THAT** item 11.1 of By-Law 478/07 be amended to state: The minutes of a meeting at which council votes on the third reading of a by-law must show the name of each member present and the vote or abstention of each member.
